Role title: Online Community Leader

- Work closely with our national staff based in Ottawa and with fellow Leaders across the country and with volunteers and advocates in your region
- Take part in webinars, calls, online discussions and campaigns to take action

This leadership role is a great opportunity for individuals who are interested in managing an online community and wish to use their skills to create change in the world. You will also actively engage community members and gain experience working in the not-for-profit sector.

You will build a close relationship with community members, and a meaningful relationship with volunteers and staff.
